Dear Prospective UUFMSMA Foundation Grantee:

The Unitarian Universalist Fellowship of San Miguel de Allende (UUFMSMA) Social Justice Foundation annually provides funds for community assistance through partnerships and grants to local nonprofit organizations. We are continuing the tradition of promoting self-sufficiency, empowerment for self-advocacy, community-generated ideas, and health and education - with a focus on the residents of central Mexico. As a matter of policy, we focus on grants that will benefit disadvantaged or vulnerable populations. The Foundation strives to be inclusive of all people and to embrace the diversity of the human community without discrimination.

We are currently involved in fundraising for 2025 and will be awarding grants for program operations or one-time projects.

Timelines for 2025 Grant Application process:

On January 31, 2025 – We will email the grant request form to previously funded organizations. The document to be completed is included in this packet.

On March 15, 2025 – We will begin accepting proposals on this date.

(Or proposals can be submitted later during the year, as needs arise.)

We ask that our forms be completed in Microsoft Word (.docx) format, and, if possible, in English.

However, Spanish can be accommodated.

May 1, 2025 (approximately) – The first Foundation grants for 2024 will begin to be awarded and notifications will be sent.

Follow up reporting schedule: As in the past, we will ask grant recipients to complete a brief Interim Report by November 1, 2025, and a Final Report before any 2026 grant application. These reports will be focused on how the UUFMSMA Foundation grant award is being used.
